The Syracuse Metropolitan Transportation Council (SMTC) seeks a Transportation Analyst. The SMTC is the designated Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) for Onondaga County and small portions of Madison and Oswego Counties. Experience or familiarity with the MPO processes is highly desirable.

This mid-level position requires a highly technical, motivated, and experienced transportation and/or planning professional. The major work areas for this position include Travel Demand Modeling, Geographic Information Systems (GIS), and transportation/traffic analysis. The starting salary for this position will be between \$39,000 – \$52,000 DOQ. The position has a current upper salary range of \$57,500.

At a minimum, the ideal candidate shall have a four-year degree in Planning (Urban and Regional or Transportation), Civil/Traffic Engineering or a closely related field plus a minimum of three (3) years of directly related relevant experience. A Masters degree can substitute for one year of experience. Excellent ARC GIS skills are of particular interest.

The SMTC provides a competitive benefit package including Medical and Dental Insurance, the NYS Retirement System, generous leave benefits and an optional Deferred Compensation Plan.
