

JOB TITLE: CONTRACT TRANSPORTATION PLANNER

The Southern NH Planning Commission (SNHPC), the Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) for Manchester area, has an opening for a contract Transportation Planner.

Under supervision of the Senior Transportation Planner, the Transportation Planner will perform independent work in analyses and development of techniques and procedures regarding transportation planning activities with emphasis on public transit planning; monitor and review transportation and transit planning projects and programs to ensure consistency with Transportation Plan; conduct research studies toward development of local and regional transportation/transit programs and projects; prepare transit service recommendations, routing options, strategies for service changes and service performance evaluation; advise public officials, other agencies and general public with respect to transportation and transit plans and programs, and perform other related work as may be required.

The ideal candidate will possess the following qualifications: Considerable knowledge in analyzing and interpreting data, policies, procedures and techniques of local and regional transportation planning and transit planning; ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with funding agencies, interested groups, public officials, other employees, and general public; additional skills such as hands-on experience with GIS, knowledge of principles and practices of travel demand forecasting, and hands-on experience in use of traffic engineering software packages considered a plus.

Master's Degree in Urban or Regional Planning with specialization in transportation planning required, plus two years experience in recognized planning office or in practice of transportation/transit planning. Salary range \$21.00 to \$23.00 per hour based on qualifications.
