Salary competitive. Formed in 1961, ABAG was California's first council of governments and is the official comprehensive planning agency for the Bay Area. The Bay Area includes the nine counties of Alameda, Contra Costa, Marin, Napa, San Francisco, San Mateo, Santa Clara, Solano and Sonoma. The 101 cities and all nine counties are voluntary members of ABAG, representing nearly all of the region's 7 million people. Challenges that they address include housing, transportation, the environment, earthquakes and equity. An elected official from each member city and county serves as a delegate to ABAG's General Assembly, and there is a 38-member Executive Board. ABAG has about 75 employees and a FY 2010-2011 operating budget of \$23 million. The Executive Director is appointed by and serves at the pleasure of the Executive Board, and also serves as Secretary-Treasurer of the Agency. Desire the equivalent of a relevant master's degree and 10-15 years of responsible managerial and fiscal control experience. Executive level regional council of government or city/county management experience is desirable. Candidates from state/federal government or the private sector will also be considered. California experience is important, as knowledge of the State government and current legislation will impact ABAG's future funding and programming. Should have demonstrated experience/knowledge of budget and finance, planning and land use, housing, transportation, obtaining grants, technology and organization planning.
