

**EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR**  
**ALAMEDA COUNTY TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION (ACTC)**

Salary highly competitive. Alameda County is the geographic center of the San Francisco Bay Area and, while 20% of the Bay Area's population lives there, nearly 40% of the region's freeway congestion occurs in the County. The merger of the Alameda County Congestion Management Agency (ACCMA) and the Alameda County Transportation Improvement Authority (ACTIA) will form a new joint powers authority – ACTC. This merger will allow for better coordination of transportation planning and programming within the County, as well as position Alameda County jurisdictions and transit agencies to better compete for limited state and federal transportation dollars.

The Executive Director will report to a new 22-member Board representing Alameda County, the 14 cities located in the County, BART and AC Transit (the two largest transit operators in the County). At present, ACCMA has 25 employees, a FY 2009/10 operating budget of \$5.4 million, and an overall annual budget of \$69.7 million. ACTIA has 9 employees, a FY 2009/10 operating budget of \$4.5 million, and an overall annual budget of \$142.6 million.

Desire the equivalent of a relevant BA/BS (particularly in civil or transportation engineering) and 10 years of executive/senior management or administrative experience in a municipal or public agency setting. Desire 5 years or more of executive level transportation management experience in at least 2 of the following areas: transportation planning, programming, project delivery or finance. Should have extensive experience in federal, state, regional and local legislative processes, with demonstrated results in influencing staff decisions. California experience preferred.
